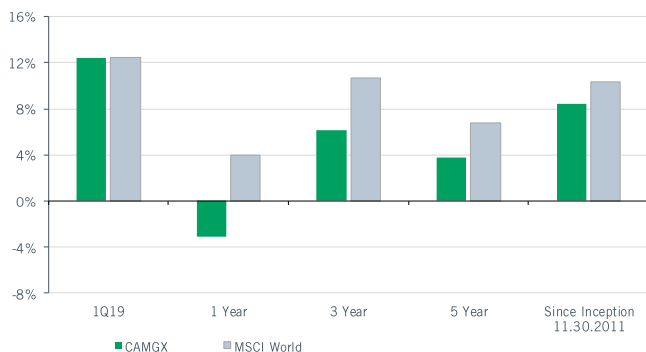

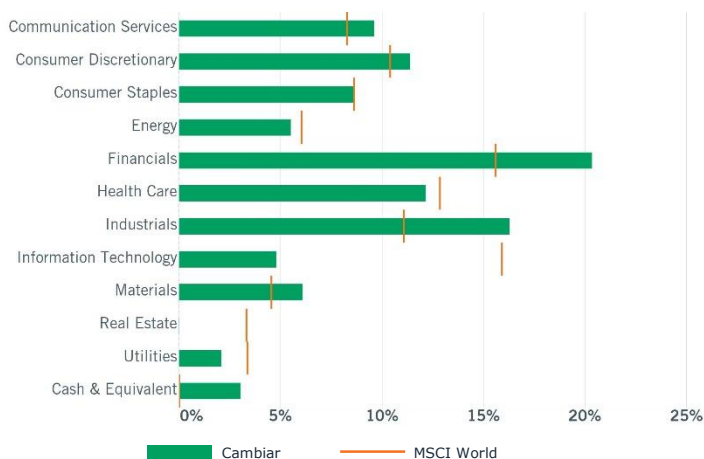

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¹AUS (assets under supervision) includes UMA/model portfolios that are non-discretionary assets. AUS and AUM are preliminary. Risk statistic definitions are as follows: Alpha is a measure of risk-adjusted performance. Beta is a measure of risk in relation to the market or benchmark. The Sharpe Ratio is a direct measure of reward-to-risk and is calculated by subtracting the risk free rate from the rate of return for a portfolio and dividing the result by the standard deviation. Standard Deviation is a statistical measure of historical volatility; a measure of the extent to which numbers are spread around their average. R-Squared measures how closely a portfolio's performance correlates with the performance of a benchmark index. Risk statistics are based off a five year time frame. P/E ratio 1 YR Forecast is a calculation that divides the current share price by the estimates of earnings in the next four quarters. Debt/Equity - Long Term is a calculation that takes interest bearing, long-term debt divided by shareholder equity. EPS Growth - Long Term is a calculation that takes the company's estimated profits for five years divided by the outstanding shares. Active share is a holdings-based measure of active management representing the percentage of securities in a portfolio that differ from those in the benchmark index. These calculations are not a forecast of the Fund's future performance.
